



Mother's Day Gift Stall 2025

Dear Parent/Carer

FOSP will be organising a stall of Mother's Day gifts so the children can buy a gift for their Mum, Grandma or another special woman in their lives.

There will be a selection of different gifts so the children will have a choice of which to buy. All gifts will cost £3 each and will be gift wrapped. The shop will be in the ICT room at lunchtime on Friday 21st March and Friday 28th March.

You can buy gifts via Ticketsource - our set-up on there means you can purchase gifts for one child at a time, providing us with their name and class. If you have more than one child at school, you will need to provide a name, choose their class and then select how many gifts you would like to select for each child. Once you have booked for that child you will then need to complete a second booking for any siblings at the school. The link to pay for gifts is here:
